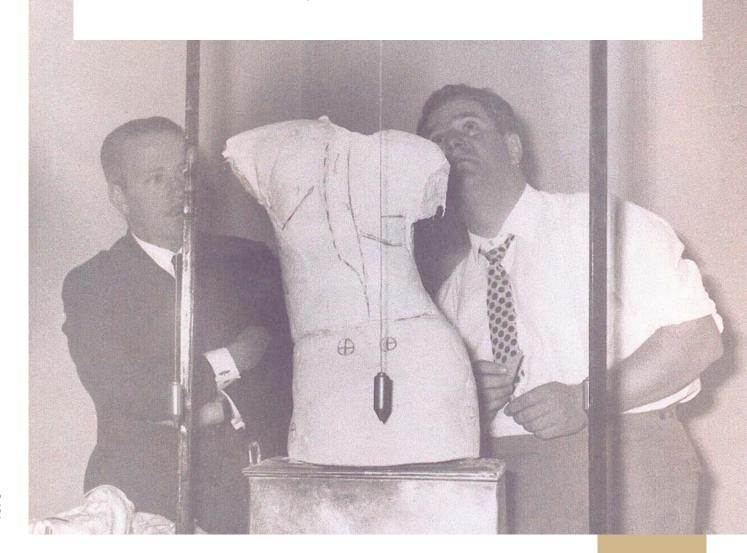
In 2020, the PRIM Group celebrated its 150th anniversary doing what it does best: putting its commitment and innovative instinct at the service of the health sector.

PRIM is a Spanish private equity business group that has been listed on the Madrid Stock Exchange since 1985. Thanks to the daily efforts of the almost 600 people that form part of it, the company has a diversified business portfolio that endorses its leadership in the field of orthopaedics and technical aids and its position as a strategic supplier for hospitals and sectors such as physiotherapy and rehabilitation, pharmacy products, and wellness facilities. Its export network stands testament to its international scope, offering solid coverage to more than 75 countries.

Renowned within the market for its avant-garde products, PRIM is committed to constantly seeking out new solutions, whether through its own innovation or alongside its strategic partners. The organisation registered its first patent in 1888 and has played a pioneering role in bringing emerging technologies to the market ever since.

Maintaining its family values, the group's quality excellence, adaptability to customer demands and the specialised technical advice that comes with its products are the three competitive advantages that have earned its status as one of the only 32 Spanish companies founded before 1900 to still be operational today.

In 2020, the uncertainty and vulnerable scenarios brought about by COVID-19 put the company's financial strength and resilience to the test. However, its rapid response to new demands, increased synergy between businesses, efficient readjustment of stock levels to sure up distribution channels, and operating expense optimisation saw the company close the year with a total turnover of 147.3 million euros, a figure similar to 2019.

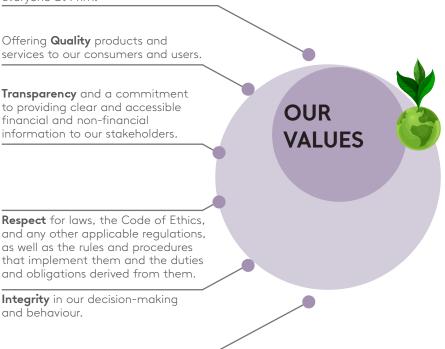

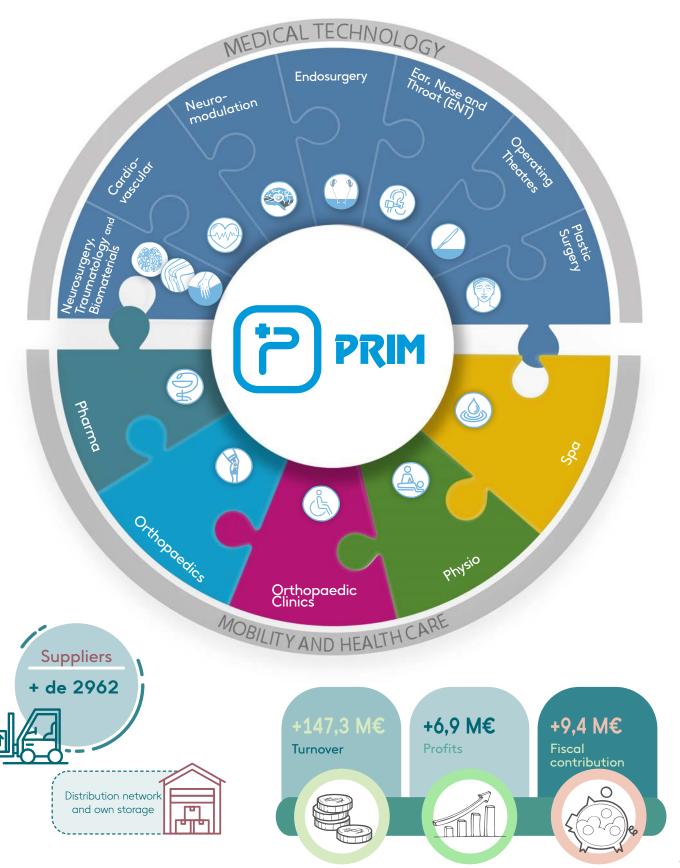

EXCELSIUSGPS™ ROBOT

The ExcelsiusGPS ™ robot is a robotic navigation system that revolutionises minimally invasive spinal surgery. It provides real-time visualisation of instrument positioning and screw placement in the spine.

Using the ExcelsiusGPS™ minimises risks during surgery, improves workflow, and increases the available information to improve decision-making.



AIRSEAL® IFS

AirSeal® iFS is the world's only intelligent and integrated access system for laparoscopic and robotic surgery, representing a revolutionary transformation from conventional insufflation systems. This innovative system makes it possible to perform laparoscopic surgeries at much lower intra-abdominal pressures than with a conventional insufflator.

The system means that laparoscopic surgeries can be brought into line with Enhanced Recovery After Surgery protocols (ERAS).



CELLA MEDICAL SOLUTIONS

The Cella Medical Solutions virtual models empower surgeons by allowing them to plan for complex surgical interventions with a digital simulation that uses virtual 3D models of human organs. The innovative software navigates through the organs, minimising the risk of causing new injuries during surgery and dimensioning the real scope of the pathology.

The virtual model can be printed in transparent resin with a 3D printer to provide a complete and life-size image of the organs and their surroundings.



TASKA HAND

Taska hand is the world's first waterproof bionic prosthesis. With more than twenty types of grip, the bionic hand works with the microelectronic signals in the remaining arm, allowing patients to perform a diverse range of activities, such as brushing their teeth, grasping objects, driving or lifting up to 20 kg of weight.

Its IP67 waterproof rating means it can be submerged up to 1 metre deep for a maximum of 30 minutes without damage.



VERNACARE WASTE DISPOSAL UNIT

The Vernacare organic waste disposal unit offers an innovative system that uses single-use containers which are subsequently disposed of in the bedpan macerator installed inside the hospital. Destroying the containers and organic waste in the same device reduces the risk of infection by preventing crosscontamination, which is vital for the management of COVID-19.



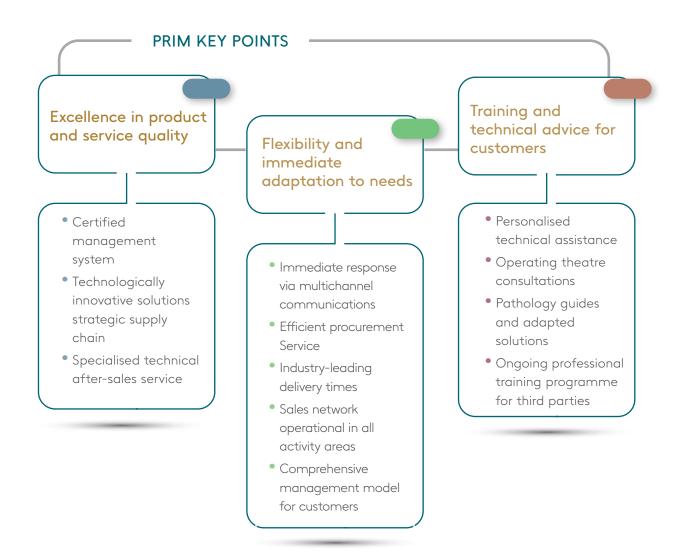
COMFORSIL SEAMLESS RANGE

PRIM has led the way in developing and marketing the first ever line of seamless podiatry products made using bonding technology. Corrective Hallux Valgus orthotics and protective orthotics for both the Hallux and metatarsals combine lycra with different elasticities and a silicone hydrogel padding to correct the position of the first toe without introducing solid pressure elements.

Consequently, it operates a strict control model to ensure the traceability of human tissue products distributed in Spain, from the authorised tissue banks or establishments in the European Union to the health centres approved for the implantation

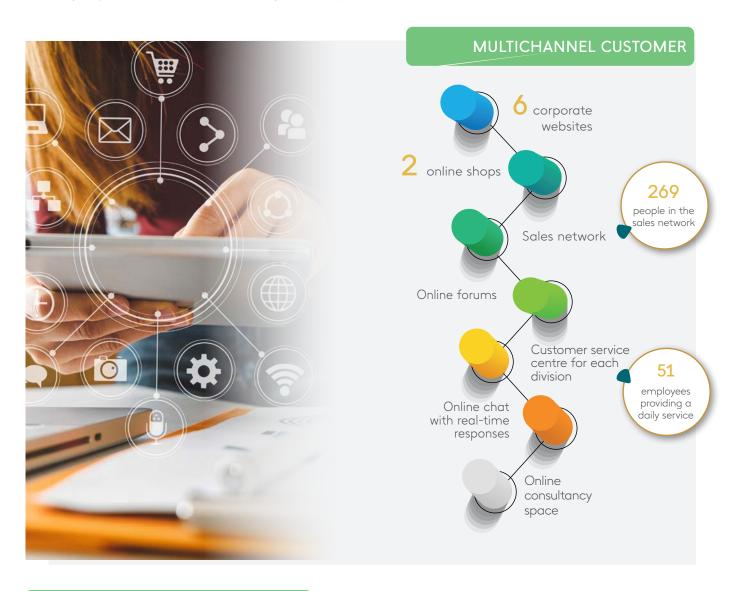
INFORMATION SECURITY AND PRIVACY

In some divisions, such as Neuromodulation, the product managers support the patient throughout the useful life of the implants. In the Orthopaedic sector, our technicians assist the patient from a technical and emotional perspective to help them integrate new realities into their everyday life. In specialist areas like Neurosurgery, Traumatology and Endosurgery, product specialists are present during surgeries, when necessary, to ensure the correct functioning of the product.

TECHNICAL TRAINING

PRIM takes a proactive approach to sharing the knowledge of all agents in the health sector as a tool for updating resources and improving service quality. 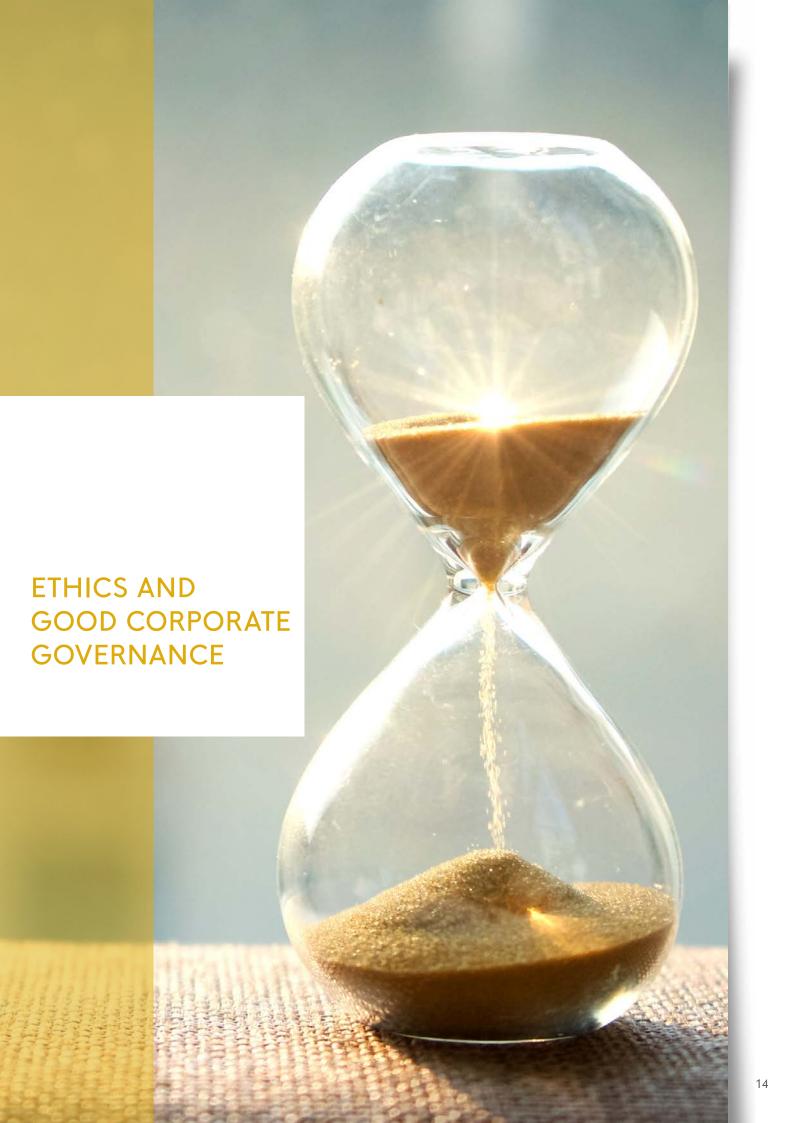

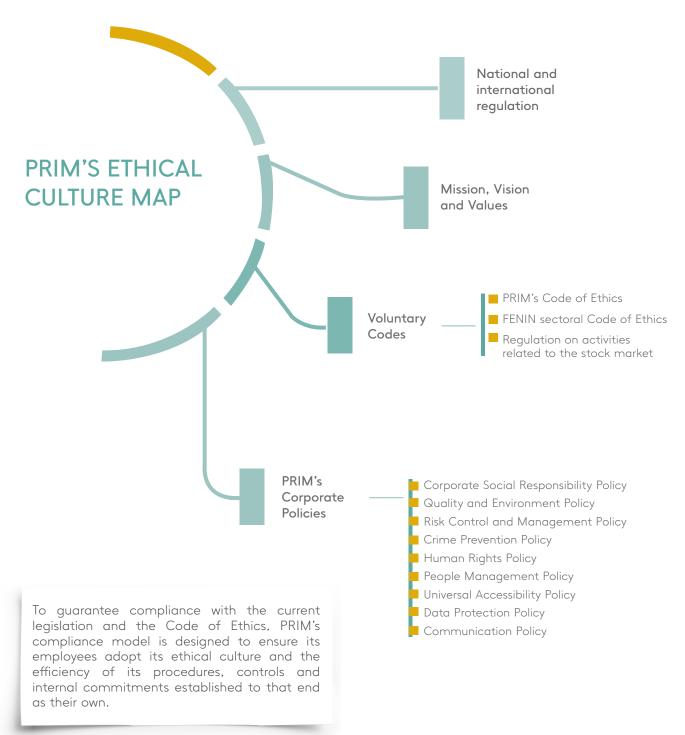

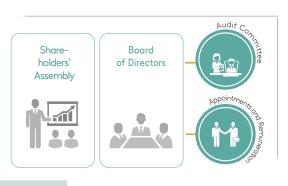

Structure of PRIM's Board of Directors

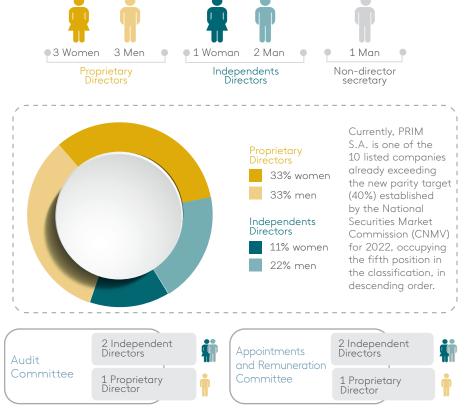
Prim's Board of Directors is selected on the basis of three criteria:
